




2.0 ILLUSTRATION OF YOUR GIRAFFE

5.0 UNPACKING AND ASSEMBLING YOUR GIRAFFE





STOP!

If in any doubt, ALWAYS seek ADVICE.

Always turn hand wheels, levers and screws clockwise to tighten or anti-clockwise to loosen.

- When delivered, the product will be supplied in two parts; a Giraffe head (E), and a Giraffe body (F).
- Position the Giraffe body on a flat surface and fix the Giraffe head to the body using the three hand wheels provided (see below, G).
- Connect the box flange (H) to the top of the randomizer box (I), using two hand wheels, as shown below.
- Your Giraffe is now ready to use.


